PART-II : RULES & REGULATIONS :

The College has certain rules & regulations which are strictly followed. These rules & regulations are to be followed by all students without exception. Students and guardians are to be aware of these rules and regulations which are mentioned below.

DISCIPLINE :

- (1) Pandu College is cosmopolitan in nature in terms of students' enrolment. Besides local residents, students from Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram, Arunachal Pradesh & other neighbouring states get themselves admitted to this college. All students study peacefully maintaining harmony and fellow feelings. Students are expected to uphold this tradition. Any controversy may immediately be brought to the notice of the Principal or Disciplinary Committee.
- (2) Students are not allowed to use mobile phones or any other electronic gadgets in the college campus.
- (3) Students should carry their Identity Cards while they are in the College campus.
- (4) Damaging property of the college is considered as criminal offence and if proved may lead to rustication.
- (5) Pandu College campus was declared as 'Tobacco Free Zone' on 31st May -05. Therefore chewing pan & gutka, spitting & smoking cigarette are strictly prohibited. Violation of this is severely dealt with in the form of punishment like expulsion.
- (6) Sticking bills, writing on the walls and black boards by the students are not permitted.
- (7) Students are not supposed to disturb other classes by loitering on the corridor during their off periods. They can utilise their off-periods in the library or common room.
- (8) Any student involved in indisciplinary activities within the college campus, will be warned by giving red mark in Academic Calendar cum Progress Record. Repetition of activities may lead to expulsion.

ATTENDANCE :

- (1) A student is not considered eligible to sit for Council / University Examination as regular candidate if he / she has not attended a minimum 75% of classes held in each subject of his study. For scholarship holder 75% attendance is a must.
- (2) Non-attendance on medical or other valid ground is considered if application be made through this record book either prior to leave or within 7 days of joining the class.
- (3) Presence in certain events like Independence day, Republic day, College week etc. is mandatory.
- (4) Classes will continue upto middle of February and no class will be held during University or Council Examinations starting from 3rd week of

February. All students are to attend classes even after the last unit test.

DRESS CODE :

- (1) The college uniform for boys & girls are as mentioned below :
Male Student : Red checked shirt & black trouser with monogra. Black shoes and black socks.
Female Student : Red checked Kurta with monogram. White salwar & white churni. **or**
 Red Mekhela, White Chaddar with Red border and Red ckecked blouse with monogram.
Winter Wear : Deep maroon sweater or blazer with monogram for both male and female students.
- (2) Monogram of the college is to be used in the uniform.
- (3) Wearing of uniform is compulsory.
- (4) No student with loud design is permitted in the campus.
- (5) With due permission from the authority students are allowed to wear ethnic dresses in special occasion. In that case also wearing of tight-fit dresses are not-desirable.

EXAMINATION :

- (1) There will be sessional examination in each subject sessional examination will be conducted by the examination committee of the college.
- (2) Marks of Internal assessment will depend on the performance of sessional examination
- (3) Students will be informed about the syllabus of examination by the department before each unit test.
- (4) Examined scripts will be returned after each unit test on submission of this academic calendar where the marks will be recorded. Students are to get signature of their guardians & submit it within 7 days to the office to be checked by IQAC and receive back from IQAC after necessary verification.
- (5) Those who remain absent in unit test are also asked to get signature from HODs, guardians & then submit to the IQAC office.
- (6) Those who fail to follow the procedure mentioned above will have to face punishment (including discollegiate).
- (7) Students not appearing in all the unit tests will not get internal assesment marks in the final examination of the Council or the University.

RECORD BOOK :

- (1) This record book is to be submitted to IQAC within 7 days of starting of classes. This book will be returned to students after necessary verification by IQAC.
- (2) This book shall be produced for obtaining any certificate, scholarship and during filling of examination form.
- (3) Loss or damage of this booklet will reflect the callous or deliberate attitude of the student and may delay in obtaining of certificates, scholarship etc from the college.
